KEDCO Assures BUK of Improved Power Supply

The Management of Kano Electricity Distribution Company (KEDCO) has assured Bayero University of improved and constant electricity supply as part of its efforts to sustain the long-standing cordial relationship between the two institutions.

This was disclosed by the Chief Commercial Officer (CCO) of KEDCO, Malam Abubakar Yusuf on behalf of the Managing Director/Chief Executive Officer (CEO), of the Company Ahmed Dangana, when he received the Management of Bayero University, Kano led by the Vice

According to the JAMB Boss Bayero University has always gone to great lengths in verifying the A' Level qualifications used by candidates to gain admission into its programmes. This measure has helped to detect the use of fake certificates by some candidates who had applied to study in your institution and were admitted.

What is worthy of note is that the infraction was not concealed within the institution but brought to the knowledge of the Board and other stakeholders.

In view of the above, “the Board, wishes to acknowledge the fact that your institution has made a difference, in the fight against forgery of certificates and it is hoped you will continue to make a difference,” the statement said.

Malam Abubakar assured that KEDCO would not toy with its premier customers that pay their electricity bills regularly, saying that BUK was one among the few that often met its obligation in terms of settlement of electricity bills. He said for this reason and barring any unforeseen challenges, KEDCO would not relent in its efforts to satisfy the yearnings of its dedicated customers.

The KEDCO Chief Commercial Officer told the Vice Chancellor that the company sometimes faced unforeseen technical challenges which often resulted in major power outages. 'We are in business, our desire is to sell electricity to enable us to meet our numerous obligations. Incessant power outages are not our target. Our target is to supply constant electricity to our customers in order to make more money', he remarked.

He said KEDCO had noted all the complaints and challenges Bayero University was facing as a result of power outages, and assured that there would be a new lease of life in electricity supply to the institution.

Earlier, the Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas thanked the Management of KEDCO for the cordial relationship and assured that all efforts would be intensified to cement the relationship.

He told the KEDCO Management that the University was populated by over 60,000 inhabitants including students and staff, in addition to lecture theatres, laboratories all desirous of power to function. The Vice Chancellor added that conscious of these facts, the University Management made it a point of duty to ensure prompt settlement of electricity bills every month.

'We have never defaulted in settling our electricity obligation and wondered why the University cannot get constant power supply,' the Vice Chancellor said.

He said Bayero University and KEDCO had a long-standing history of cordial relationship therefore the organisation would do everything possible to sustain such relationship through provision of improved and constant supply of electricity to the University.

The Vice Chancellor also drew the attention of his host to the unannounced tariff hike that affected one of the Campuses of the University and called on the KEDCO Management to reconsider the hike issue. He appealed for the installation of meter in the affected campus to address the problem of estimated billings.

The Vice Chancellor equally spoke about the University being disconnected by KEDCO agents anytime the

company was embarking on general disconnection exercise not minding whether the University was up-to-date in the settlement of its power bill. Professor Abbas, however, advised KEDCO to involve technology such that only defaulting customers were disconnected as against its current system where everybody was affected by the general exercise.

VC Appoints Rabiou Dauda to Oversee Bursary Department

The Vice Chancellor, Professor Sagir Adamu Abbas has approved the appointment of Malam Rabiou Dauda to oversee the affairs of the Bursary Department pending the appointment of a substantive Bursar.

In a letter dated 16th March, 2023 signed by the Registrar, Malam Jamil Ahmad Salim said the appointment takes

effect from Monday 20th March, 2023.

As an overseer of Bursary Department, he would be the Chief Financial Officer of the University and be responsible to the Vice Chancellor for the day-to-day administration and control of financial affairs of the university.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants for Admission into the programmes must satisfy the following conditions:

FIVE CREDITS 'O LEVEL' RESULTS WITHOUT JAMB – (NON-UTME CANDIDATES)

- a) **Applicants with SSCE O Level results or its equivalent WITHOUT JAMB RESULTS are eligible to apply** once they have a minimum of five 'O' Level credits in relevant subjects including English at not more than two sittings.

FIVE CREDITS 'O LEVEL' RESULTS WITH JAMB – (UTME CANDIDATES)

- b) **Applicants with JAMB Results can equally apply.** Those with a minimum of **180** JAMB scores who choose Bayero University, Kano as their first choice in the regular programme will be given priority.
- c) Applicants for admission into B. Sc. Accounting, B.Sc. Business Administration, B.Sc. Mathematics, B. Sc. (Ed) Mathematics, B. Sc. Health Education and B. Sc. (Ed) Economics must also have credits in '**O' Level Mathematics**.
- d) Holders of National Board for Arabic and Islamic Studies Certificates (NBAIS) can only apply for B. A. Arabic and B. A. Islamic Studies.

DIRECT ENTRY ADMISSION

Applicants for Admission into the programmes must satisfy the following conditions:

- a) Possess a recognized Advanced Level qualification in the area relevant to the programme of choice. Such qualification(s) include(s) **National Diploma (ND)**,

Nigeria Certificate in Education (NCE), Interim Joint Matriculation Board (IJMB) – (with a minimum of 6 points), Nursing Certificate, Diploma in Health Education, Diploma in Community Health, Diploma in Environmental Health, General Certificate of Education (GCE), ‘A’ Level and any other relevant qualification(s).

- b) Possess a minimum of **five (5) ‘O’ Level Credits** in relevant subjects, including English.
- c) In addition, applicants for admission into B. Sc. Accounting, B.Sc. Business Administration, B.Sc. Mathematics, B. Sc. (Ed) Mathematics and B. Sc. (Ed) Economics must also have credits in **‘O’ Level Mathematics**. While candidates for B. Nursing Science must have **credits in English, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry and Physics**.
- d) Similarly, applicants for admission into B. Sc. Health Education must have **credits in English, Mathematics, Biology and any other relevant science subject(s)**.
- e) Holders of National Board for Arabic and Islamic Studies Certificates (NBAIS) can only apply for B. A. Arabic and B. A. Islamic Studies.
- f) Candidates applying for B. Sc. Public Administration should possess a credit in Government/History in addition.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Step - 1 An applicant **MUST** first visit **JAMB Online Application Platform for Part-Time Degree Programme**, select BUK, access the form, fill it and then make a non-refundable payment of **Three Thousand Five Hundred Naira only (N3,500:00)** into the JAMB’S Account from **Monday 2nd January 2023**.

NOTE: Applicants must fill in **New JAMB Forms** purposely meant for Part-Time Degree Programme to obtain JAMB Registration Number. **Old JAMB Forms/Registration Numbers will not be accepted.**

Step - 2 Applicant can then approach the University Portal - www.buk.edu.ng with effect from **Monday 2nd January 2023** and Click **PART-TIME_APPLICATION FORM** at the homepage. Login **PROGRAMME SELECTED** and **GENDER**.

Step - 3 User should create account at the Portal. Username and Password will be provided.

Step - 4 After you login, fill in all the necessary sections provided by the Application Portal.

Step - 5 Generate your personalized invoice. The invoice is to be printed and taken to any Bank to make a payment of Processing Fee of **Ten Thousand Naira (N10,000:00) only. Ensure you read the Payment Procedure carefully at the Payment Procedure Page.**

Step - 6 Review your form to ensure accuracy of all information you have provided.

Step - 7 Provide your JAMB number before printing acknowledgement slip.

Remember, old JAMB numbers used for other admissions will not be accepted.

Step - 8 After completion, generate your Acknowledgement Slip. Print the Slip and keep it safe. The Slip will be needed during the collection of Admission Letter and during Registration.
